İzmir is an attractive cosmopolitan city with lots of history and interesting places to visit both inside and outside the city boundaries. İzmir is the successor of almost 3,500 years of urban past, and possibly up to that much more in terms of advanced human settlement pattern.

1st Day: Visiting Izmir University

2nd day: Izmir City Center Tour: Konak – Kemeraltı:

Konak is considered the touristic center of Izmir and is full of historical mosques, the famous clock tower and many small streets with cafes, restaurants and bars.



Kemeraltı Market is basically the Grand Bazaar of Izmir; it's a massive maze like market where you can buy absolutely ANYTHING. You must try Turkish coffee and bargain when you are shopping[©]



<u> 3rd Day: Ephesus - Meryem Ana – Şirince – Kuşadası Tour</u>

Ephesus is an ancient Greek city founded around 3000 years ago. It is most famous for the Temple of Artemis, one of the seven ancient wonders of the world. It was also considered the home of Mary, mother of Jesus. Entry is 30tl but if you are interested in history Ephesus is a must see.



Sirince is not far from Ephesus is a small Turkish village famous for its beautiful white houses and for making fruit wine which you can buy in shops around most of Turkey. Entry is free and you will be treated to many free glasses of wine to try as you walk around its streets. As it is very close to Ephesus it is recommended to see both these places in a one day trip.

Kuşadası is a resort town on Turkey's Aegean coast and the center of the seaside district of the same name in Aydın Province. Kuşadası lies at a distance of 95 km (59 mi) to the south from the region's largest metropolitan center of İzmir, and 71 km (44 mi) from the provincial seat of Aydın situated inland. Its primary industry is tourism.



4th Day: Çeşme – Alaçatı Tour:

Çeşme is currently the most famous holiday resort for Turkish tourists and is becoming increasingly popular with the foreign visitors.Cesme offers an upmarket, authentic holiday experience and is home to the second best surfing waters in the world.

It is in an ideal location, just a 40 minute drive from Izmir Adnan Menderes Airport that receives direct flights from all over the world year round.





5th Day: Izmir Alsancak-Kordon Tour

Alsancak is a centrally situated large quarter in İzmir, Turkey, within the boundaries of the metropolitan district of Konak. As a notional zone, Alsancak extends from along the tip of the southern shores of the Gulf of İzmir, starting near İzmir's historic square that carries the same name as the district (Konak Square) with the 19th century-built Pasaport Quai marking the point, and extending along a 3200-meter-long seaside street and promenade called "Kordon". In this zone, you can find lots of beautiful shops, restaurants and bar.
